Section 2 must go in Administrative Proposal, etc.)	Adminstrative - NYSIF Appendices D - Y, and NDA Cost - Appendix Z Technical - All other responses required of the bidder in the RFP.
3	pg 24	Section 4.2	Is the "Fee Proposal" the same as the "Cost Proposal"?	Yes.
4	pg 24-25	Section 4.2	The RFP instructions state to answer in the order asked. That being said, section 2 asks for a list of things, but then section 4 gives a different format. Shall we follow section 4's format (starting with section 4), then insert section 2's information when section 4.2.4 prompts us to, or do we start with providing all information requested in section 2, then move on to section 4?	You may include these responses however you see fit as long as they are labeled and clearly identify which RFP Section you are responding to.
5	pg 14	Section 2.1	RFP states that we must answer/attest to everything, does that mean you would like us to certify that we understand each portion of the RFP (including section 1 and 3) or just provide what is expressly asked?	Firms must attest to their ability to meet all mandatory requirements outlined in Attachment 1 and provide any documentation requested within Attachment 1.
