



The Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, ensures public access to all records and documents maintained by government agencies with certain exceptions. The Personal Privacy Protection Law pertains to personal information collected and maintained by state agencies.

Requests to review and/or copy records must be submitted in writing to the NYSIF Records Access Officer. Paper copies of records will be provided at a cost of \$.25 per page. Requests may either be sent by regular mail or electronic mail at the following addresses:
