

## SAFETY BASICS

### ELECTRICAL SAFETY (GFCI)

Use Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCI) protectors on electrical outlets near sinks in restrooms and kitchens. GFCI prevent electrical shock when used on outlets near water and damp sources.

Do not obstruct panel or electrical boxes with storage.

Report all damaged electrical outlets.

Place guarding on electrical lighting if it is in close proximity to storage. If materials strike the lighting fixture, bulbs could fall and result in injury.

Do not snip off the ground prong of an electrical cord to fit a two pronged outlet. This could lead to electrical shock.
