## 1. IN SCOPE

## 1.1 HPQC Project Migration

Migrate data from HPQC to qTest, with following information:

- HPQC: Quality Center On-Premise 12.55
- qTest: On-Premise
- Number of HPQC projects: Around 155 projects as per migration form (30 Large & around 125 Small Projects)

## 2.1 HPQC projects

• NYSIF will export qcp files and provide to Tricentis for migration.

## NYSIF Data Migration from HPQC to qTest On-Premise

Scope and Estimation

## Effective Date: 12/4/2019

- One HPQC project is migrated into one qTest project, it doesn't allow to merge/split project.
- Migrate data from exported QCP files into new projects on qTest, not to existing projects on qTest.
- As the migration standard process, the migration tool migrates data fully per object type, it doesn't filter data per object type.
- The tool migrates the same data types from HPQC to qTest. qTest doesn't allow to change data types on qTest Projects after migration.
- By default, Releases and Milestones will be migrated to qTest as a must if HP ALM projects have.
- In case projects required to migrate test case instances only, the status of their test runs will be unexecuted because test run's status is based on the status of the latest test log.

### 2.2 Attachments

- No ability to add attachments at qTest folder levels (Requirement Folder, Test Case Folder, Test Step Calling, Test Suites, Test Cycles, and Test Runs) in qTest.
- Attachments over 50 MB will not be migrated over to qTest (It's only applicable on qTest cloud)

### 2.3 Integrations

• There is NO integration migration since qTest doesn't support API to migrate integrations, users need to set up manually after migration.

### 2.4 Reports

• There is NO reports migration since qTest does not support API to migrate reports.

### 2.5 User Migration

- In case client want to migrate user, please provide the user list for each HPQC projects in CSV format, with following migration:
  - Username The username of HPQC user account.
  - Full Name The full name associated to HPQC user account.
  - Email HPQC doesn't require email address but it is required by qTest to create the user's account.
  - qTest Profile This is optional, if you don't provide profiles, the migration tool will assign to a default profile. One qTest user belongs to only one qTest User profile while a HPQC, a user has multiple roles, so you need to make the decision for one profile per user in qTest.
