The following (Q&A) will serve as Amendment #1 to NYSIF's Request for Quotes (RFQ) for Industrial Hygienist services, bid number 2021-11-INS. Material in this Amendment supersedes any contradictory material in the RFP.

A. Section 4 of the RFO is hereby deleted and replaced in entirety by the following:

4. METHOD OF AWARD & DISTRIBUTION OF WORK

NYSIF will award contracts based on Region; NYSIF anticipates multiple awards for each Region. Please refer to Attachment 3, "Map of Regions" for the geographic areas of responsibility. Bidders must specify which region(s) they are seeking a contract for work, and Bidders may contract in more than one region. Contractors will be placed on a panel for each Region awarded.

NYSIF will issue Statements of Work (SOW) to awarded panel Firm(s) based upon the geographical location of the work. Panel Firm(s) will be required to submit responses to the SOW detailing the project specifics (e.g. scope, deliverables, effort, cost, etc.). Work will be awarded based on an evaluation of the proposals.

No minimum amount of work is guaranteed.

RESERVED RIGHTS:

- 1. NYSIF reserves the right to request proposals from ALL contracted Firm(s), regardless of region, if it is determined to be in the best interest of NYSIF.
- If the contracted Firms in a Region are unable to complete an assignment for any reason, NYSIF reserves the right to assign the work to Firms awarded in adjacent Regions.

Please note that the due date for the submission of bids **remains unchanged**. All bids are due April 21, 2021, by 2:00 p.m.(eastern).
