



HEALTHCARE FRAUD

Healthcare fraud deprives injured workers of the care they deserve. When a medical provider bills an insurance company for care, treatment or a test that was not provided, the medical provider is committing fraud.

Healthcare fraud in workers' compensation insurance typically involves the misrepresentation of medical treatment for injured workers.

TYPES OF HEALTHCARE FRAUD

Ordering unnecessary treatment, medication or tests

Billing for tests or treatment the injured worker hasn't received

Depriving an injured worker of proper treatment

Unnecessarily prolonging the duration of treatment

RED FLAGS FOR HEALTHCARE FRAUD

- 1 Healthcare billing statements with questionable, unexplained charges
- 2 Billing both a workers' compensation insurer and a health insurer for the same services
- 3 Prescribing highly addictive pain medication, such as OxyContin or fentanyl



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
