## **CLIMATE ACTION PLEDGE**

Our organization recognizes that health care entities, particularly hospitals, are significant sources of the greenhouse gas ("GHG") emissions that cause climate change, that climate change is a threat to human health and worker safety, and that it is critical to take action to manage the workplace risks associated with climate change.

## Our organization voluntarily pledges to:

1.	Work towards the goal of reducing GHG emissions throughout the operational entities covered by our workers' compensation policy by:
	at least 40% by 2030 and at least 85% by 2050 from 1990 levels (consistent with the objectives of the New York State Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act); or
	at least 50% by 2030 (from a baseline no earlier than 2008) and achieve net-zero by 2050 (consistent with the Health Sector Climate Pledge offered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services);
2.	Enhance our resilience to severe weather events and natural disasters arising from climate change; and
3.	Develop and implement a Climate Action Plan describing how we will meet these objectives.
